# **Kaleshwaram to roar** back to life soon

#### Irrigation officials ready pump houses, firm on resuming operations

#### D CHANDRA BHASKAR RAO HYDERABAD

The Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Project (KLIP), once written off as a wasteful expenditure by the ruling Con-gress, could soon roar back into life, with irrigation officials firm on resuming pumping operations under the project and keeping all its pump houses ready.

The multi-stage project involves several pumping facilities. It has in all 35 units that manage the project's outflows at the Medigadda, Annaram and Sundilla barrages. These units play a crucial role in the reverse pumping of water from the confluence point of the Godavari and Pranahita rivers to the Sripada Yellampalli project.


The Kannepalli pump house comprises 17 giant motor pumps, each weighing 2,376 metric tonnes, and are meant for lifting water from the Godavari in the first stage.

These powerful pumps, known as 'Baahubali motors', have the capacity to lift 3,000 million cubic feet (TMC ft) of water every day. All of them have now been kept ready for resuming operations.

Since no impounding of water is allowed at this stage in the Medigadda barrage, the possibility of lifting from the natural flows has been

After battling for life for a week following a suicide attempt, Aswaraopet SI Sriramula Srinivas died at a private hospital in Hyderabad on Sunday. His vitals dropped because of the pesticide he had consumed in a bid to end his life

on June 30. The 34-year-old Srinivas hailed from Narakkapet in Nallabelli mandal of Warangal district. He was transferred to the Aswaraopet police station from Manugur in February this year. It might be reHyderabad

The State government plans to hand over operations of the Dharani portal to government agencies such as the National Informatics Centre, Centre for Good Governance or Telangana Online Services.

Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy is learnt to have asked officials to make arrangements in this regard and an official announcement is expected soon. The contract of TerraCIS, along with its technology and strategic partner Quantela Inc, which has been handling the management of the Dharani portal, will expire in October. The Congress, which has been criticising Five-member panel recommends the constitution of revenue tribunals, delegation of powers to tahsildars, setting up grievance redressal system

the Dharani Integrated Land Records Management System, including the website, had already decided to do away with the private com-pany before making changes to the system.

The new land records management system was proposed in 2018 and the Dharani portal was launched in October 2020 to digitise all land records and maintain them in a centralised storage. The previous BRS government also brought the Telangana Rights in Land and Pattadar

Pass Books Act, 2020, popularly known as the Record of Rights (RoR) Act, to bring reforms in the land records management system. Ini-tially operated by IL&FS, the management of the Dharani website was later

handed over to TerraCIS and later to Quantela Inc. Sources said the decision

to hand over the operations to State-owned agencies was part of the reforms proposed by the five-member committee led by senior Congress leader M Kodanda Reddy.

The committee was constituted by the State government soon after assuming power to study the functioning of the portal and make recommendations for its overhaul. The committee is learnt to have completed its study and prepared a draft report with recommendations to be submitted to the

Chief Minister. As part of the reforms proposed by the committee, the State government will replace the website with 'Bhu Matha'. The committee has also suggested enacting a comprehensive legislation governing land-related issues by bringing all land-related legislations of the Revenue Department under one umbrella to ensure their effective implementation.

Sena leader's son runs over woman with BMW, flees MUMBAI

In another shocking case of a hit-and-run accident in Maharashtra, a fisher-woman was killed and her husband injured when a BMW, allegedly driven by a Shiv Sena leader's son, who was reportedly drunk, rammed their two-wheeler in Mumbai's Worli early on Sunday and dragged the victims for 100 metres on the bonnet, police said.

The car was allegedly driven by Mihir Shah, the son of Rajesh Shah, a Palghar leader of the ruling MahaYuti ally Shiv Sena led by Chief Minister Eknath Shinde. IANS
