12 naxalites gunned down

BIJAPUR: As many as 12 naxalites were killed in a fierce encounter with security forces in Chhattisgarh's Bijapur district on Thursday, police said. The gunfight broke out around 9 am in a forest of south Bijapur when a joint team of security personnel was out an anti-naxalite operation and the intermittent exchange of fire lasted till late in the evening. Personnel belonging to the State police's DRG from three districts, five battalions of CoBRA and the 229th battalion of CRPF were involved in the operation. PTI

Nod for 8th Pay Commission

NEW DELHI: The Centre on Thursday decided to set up the 8th Pay Commission to revise the salaries of Central government employees and allowances of pensioners. The decision to set up the 8th Pay Commission was taken by PM Modi, I&B Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said. The term of the 7th Pay Commission will end in 2026. The chairman and two members of the Commission will be appointed soon, he added. There are over 49 lakh Central government employees and 65 lakh pensioners. PTI

KTR dares Revanth for live lie detector test

Criticises CM for using probe agencies for political vendetta

HYDERABAD

In a bold counter to the ongoing allegations against him, BRS working president KT Rama Rao on Thursday challenged Chief Minister Á Revanth Reddy to a live lie detector test before a judge to settle cases of corruption rather than wasting public money in investigations for political vendetta.

He said the investigation into the cases filed against him were costing Rs 5 crore to Rs 10 crore for investiga-

Addressing the media after a seven-hour marathon questioning by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) in connection with the Formula-E case, Rama Rao criticised the Chief Minister for using investigative agencies as tools for political vendetta. He reiterated that the corruption cases against him were filed with malafide intentions and political vendetta. He said as Revanth Reddy faced ACB and ED cases, similar cases were filed against him as well.

"I have a Sankranti offer to Revanth Reddy. Let us un-

dergo a lie detector test together and face questioning by judges in front of the media with live telecast. I am ready to appear anywhere, anytime. Let the truth come out," he said. He charged Revanth

Reddy with orchestrating false cases to distract the public from his own legal troubles in the Cash-for-Vote scam and called on the Chief Minister to stop wasting public money on baseless investigations.

The BRS working president reaffirmed his cooperation with investigative agencies, stating that he had appeared before the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) on January 9 and the ED on January 16, despite no evidence of wrongdoing or corruption. "Both agencies asked the same questions, and I have answered everything transparently," he said, reiterating his confidence in the judiciary. The ACB had asked about 80 questions, while the ED about 40, he said. Questioning the basis of the allegations, Rama Rao said, 'Where is the case here? Every transaction has been transparent and accounted for. This cannot be classified as money laundering."

ISRO docks 2 sats in space, scripts history

Becomes fourth country to achieve feat

BENGALURU

In a major boost to India's ambitious future space missions, ISRO on Thursday successfully performed the docking of satellites as part of the Space Docking Experiment (SpaDeX) and announced that post docking, control of two satellites as a single object was also achieved.

"India docked its name in space history! Good Morning India IŚRO's SpaDeX mission accomplishes historic docking success. Proud to witness this moment!" ISRO said in a post on X. With the successful docking of satellites -Chaser and Target — India has become the fourth country after the US, Russia and China to accomplish the technological feat.

Docking technology is essential when multiple rocket launches are required to achieve common mission objectives. The docking experiment is crucial for the smooth conduct of the country's ambitious future missions, including Chandrayaan-4, Gaganyaan, setting up a space station and landing an astronaut on the moon. Actor Saif stabbed 2 behind Bidar heist in Mumbai home

Bollywood star Saif Ali Khan was repeatedly stabbed by an intruder in nis nighrise apartment in upscale Bandra early on Thursday and rushed to hospital with the blade still lodged in his spine, an audacious attack that raises intriguing questions about security and celebrity life in the showbiz hub.

The 54-year-old, who received six stab injuries, including in his neck, was out of danger following an emergency surgery at the Lilavati Hospital where he was taken after the attack outside his younger son Jeh's room around 2.30 am.

The entire family -Khan, his wife, fellow star Kareena Kapoor, and their two sons, four-year-old Jeh and eight-year-old Taimur - were home in the 12th floor apartment along with their five house helps. In a statement to the po-

lice, Jeh's nanny Eliyama Philip, who first encountered the armed attacker, said he asked for Rs 1 crore. The intruder did not force

'WRONG TO BRAND MUMBAI AS UNSAFE'

MUMBAI: Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis on Thursday said the attack on Saif Ali Khan was a serious incident, but it would be wrong to call Mumbai unsafe because of it. Police were taking action, and the govern-ment will take steps to make the country's financial capital safer, said Fadnavis, who holds the Home portfolio. "I think Mumbai is the safest among mega cities in the country. It is true that some incidents take place some-times and they must be taken seriously. But to say that Mumbai is unsafe due to such incidents is not right... Its image gets maligned (due to such comments)," he said. PTI
